The door is wide open. As you step in, your attention is caught by a stage coach. The coachman is there, loading the suitcase. The travel in the past is beginning.

Here you are, carried away back into the time of the Schappistes, farmers of the past.

Then you come into a typical Bugey House : the cellar, the kitchen and the bedroom are unveiling their secrets to you.

A few steps further, you can sit by Marthe's desk in the school of the year 1900.

Continue your way and you will also meet a carder, a saddler, a cartwright, a blacksmith... so many jobs which are disappearing or which have disappeared already.

Before you leave, have a look at the still, the recipes of the home-made liqueurs and the information about the vineyard.



Created in 1990, this museum is a sheer tribute to the local lifestyle through ages, a patrimony which must be carefully preserved.
